EASY TO USE

Edesix Body Worn Cameras are easy-to-use, requiring no training. Single button press activation and automatic footage download functionality minimises staff interaction with the device.



LIGHTWEIGHT AND UNOBTRUSIVE

The wearable camera is lightweight, becoming an integral part of the uniform. Edesix Body Worn Cameras can be used with a range of popular fixings, including Tilt Mounts, Klick Fast and Alligator Clips.



UPLOAD FOOTAGE AUTOMATICALLY

If the camera records within range of configured Wi-Fi, the footage can be automatically uploaded. The camera footage can also be uploaded to VideoManager by plugging it into a network connected EdgeController.



CAPTURE HIGH-QUALITY AUDIO & VIDEO

When an incident occurs, the wearer presses the record button and the camera will commence recording, capturing audio and video. Edesix Body Worn Cameras can record for an entire shift between charges.



SECURELY REVIEW AND SHARE FOOTAGE

Uploaded footage can then be reviewed over the internet from any device - the system controls who can see the footage and, where appropriate, the footage can be shared with other members of the organisation or external partners such as police. Shared footage can be redacted to protect the identity of bystanders and bookmarked to highlight key moments within the footage.



SPEEDY DECISION MAKING

Upon review, a decision will be made on whether the piece of footage recorded is required for prosecution, training purposes, or to support an internal investigation. All priority footage to be used as evidence will remain as an 'incident', all other footage will be systematically deleted as required. Recorded footage can be audited centrally for quality purposes, with secure sharing links available for any refuted incidents.


Edesix provides you with VideoManager, the most advanced software tool for managing video footage, system users, and your suite of wearable cameras. Device and user profile management, secure link sharing and VMS integration are examples of VideoManager features.

Attacks on Lone Workers and Field Agents, both verbal and physical, are unfortunately becoming commonplace. Figures from the British Crime Survey reveal that up to 150 lone workers are attacked every day. Due to the solitary nature of their business, lone workers must be equipped to deal with a variety of unique challenges, and are often vulnerable when dealing with aggressive individuals.

Body Worn Cameras (BWCs) have proven to be an effective deterrent against aggression, and in many cases eliminate the need to activate an emergency process or make radio contact during an incident. When a confrontation does escalate, a Body Worn Camera records audible video and audio evidence for review and, when necessary, for use in court. Staff feel safer and less vulnerable to abusive behaviour when equipped with BWCs, whether out on patrol or visiting someone's residence.
